



MGS BUILDS NEW QUALITY LAB

MGS Mfg. Group completed the construction of its new quality assurance lab at the MGS Germantown molding facility.

The impressive two-story lab is 5,000 square feet in size and has floor-to-ceiling windows. The upper level holds office modules and private office space for all QA staff, along with a conference room to provide a convenient meeting space.

The lower level houses all metrology equipment, including coordinate measuring machines and vision systems. MGS also invested in a new Zeiss Metrotom 800 Computed Tomography (CT) machine. According to MGS Director of Quality Scott Wetzels, "With the Zeiss inspection system we are able to provide timely, accurate, and relevant feedback to our validation teams about internal, external, and assembly features. The ability to obtain reliable visual and dimension characterization of the product during the development and qualification phases of validation enables MGS and our customers to make informed decisions about the molding system with a greater degree of confidence."

The new lab was designed with additional space to accommodate future growth.
